

Press release on issuance of Circular No. 45/2026/TT-NHNN

Hanoi, August 28, 2026 – The Governor of the State Bank of Vietnam (SBV) has signed Circular No. 45/2026/TT-NHNN amending and supplementing a number of provisions of Circular No. 01/2024/TT-NHNN stipulating the management of serial numbers of newly printed banknotes by the SBV.

The issuance of the Circular aims to standardize the principles for printing serial numbers on cotton and polymer banknotes, thereby facilitating the SBV's management of serial numbers of newly printed banknotes.

Circular No. 45/2026/TT-NHNN comprises five (5) Articles, providing for the following amendments and supplements:

- Supplementing Point b1 after Point b, Clause 1, Article 5 regarding the principles for printing serial numbers during the banknote printing process, thereby standardizing the principles for printing serial numbers on cotton and polymer banknotes.
- Amending and supplementing Point b, Clause 1, Article 6 regarding the management of serial numbers of newly printed banknotes during the delivery and receipt of banknotes. Specifically, in cases where newly printed banknotes within the issuance reserve fund of an SBV regional branch are delivered and received in connection with the execution of a transfer order, list of serial numbers must be prepared.

Circular No. 45/2026/TT-NHNN shall enter into force on October 13, 2026.

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
